Program Description: The CIS Department Honors Program is a distinction granted to undergraduate students who exhibit academic excellence, a commitment to learning, and who complete a scholarly thesis paper on a topic in the field of computer science.

Application Requirements:

- 3.5 grade point average in Computer and Information Science
- UO cumulative grade point average of 3.00
- Have already completed CIS 313, 314, and 315
- Departmental approval from 2 -3 references
- Take four credits in Thesis (CIS 403) under the supervision of a faculty member

To improve chances for approval:

- Have a proposed topic when the application is submitted
- Obtain the signature of your proposed CIS faculty supervisor **or** the signatures of 2 - 3 faculty members who are willing to serve as references

An honors committee will review the final transcript of the candidate before making a decision to grant the Honors distinction for the Computer and Information Science Department.
